Stay Informed About Public Safety Power Shutoffs at Any Address

For public safety, PG&E may need to turn off power during severe weather to prevent wildfires. This is known as a Public Safety Power Shutoff (PSPS).

Our NEW Address Alerts can notify you about the potential for a PSPS at any address that is important to you or a loved one, even if you don't have a PG&E account.

Address Alerts might be right for you if:

- ✓ You want to know about a PSPS at home, work, school or other important location
- ✓ You are a tenant and do not have a PG&E account
- ✓ You need to stay informed about a PSPS affecting a friend or loved one
- ✓ Multiple members of your household want to be notified
