My mind said that never happened from Facebook and what was the reason? The person sent the Facebook badge with the photo and I can see that it is a scam. You can learn to recognize what is a scam. I informed my husband and he agreed it is a scam. I called the police station and was told not to text back and block it. Reporting to the police helped me to make me not a victim. If I had responded, I might have lost money or they might have gotten into my account.

If you ever notice strange texts or emails from anything out there that threaten you, please do not respond right away. Check first and if it is a scam, report it to the police.
